

# EU Exit: Changes for Visitors

The way we do business with Europe is changing and there are some key things visitors need to know before entering the UK. This advice sheet sets out the ten key areas.

## ID Cards and Visas

- Can EU citizens come to live and work in the UK after the Brexit transition has ended?
- Will anything change for non-EU/EEA citizens?
